You will join a fast-paced, dynamic team environment, performing a variety of entry-level preventive maintenance and labor assistance to the Pool Maintenance Worker III and provide exceptional customer service.

Schedule:

- Up to 20 hours per week and up to 1,000 hours per fiscal year; Saturdays and Sundays including weekday work as needed.
- Flexible hours available within reason.
- May be required to work varying shifts and days, which may include holidays.

The Essentials

- Equivalent to the completion of the 12th grade.
- Must be 18 years or older and have a valid California Class C driver license.
- Knowledge of basic hand and power tools; basic repair and maintenance procedures and practices; safe work practices and policies; and pool related experience is a bonus.
- Must have the physical ability to bend, pull, push, lift and carry up to 50 pounds.

You will assist the Pool Maintenance Worker III with pool maintenance duties which may include the following:

- Handling and applying basic pool chemicals, such as chlorine, salt, and calcium.
- Minor repairs around the pool deck and pump room.
- Maintaining the safety and appearance of the pool and deck.
- Using small electric powered equipment including blower, power-drill, saw etc.
