The Department is organized into two divisions, the Field Services Division and the Professional Services Division. THE POSITION

The City of Emeryville is currently seeking a professional, collaborative, and ethical leader to serve as the next Police Captain. The Police Captain serves as second in command of the department and is responsible for overseeing daily operations, implementing policies, setting departmental goals, and managing a team of officers and professional staff. This leadership role involves a broad range of law enforcement duties, including the protection of life and property, the enforcement of laws and ordinances, crime prevention, and conducting investigations.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will demonstrate:

- Strategic thinking and the ability to respond effectively in emergency situations
- Extensive knowledge and understanding of modern California law enforcement practices and procedures
- A strong understanding of community needs and a proactive approach to addressing them
- Exceptional leadership and decision-making skills, with the ability to perform under pressure
- A genuine commitment to coaching, mentoring, and developing staff
- Clear and effective communication skills, both verbal and in written
- Strong interpersonal skills, with the ability to listen and understand, de-escalate situations, and build positive relationships
- A commitment to community-oriented policing and public safety





QUALIFICATIONS

Education:

Graduation from a four-year college or university with major coursework in police science, criminal justice, leadership and management, psychology, business administration, or a related field. Postgraduate education or a master's degree in a related discipline is desired

Experience:

A minimum of five (5) years of progressively responsible experience in law enforcement, including at least three (3) years as a Lieutenant or above in a Patrol setting

Licenses and Certifications:

- Possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's License. Out-of-state valid Motor Vehicle Operator's will be accepted during the application process.
- Possession of an Advanced Certificate issued by the California Department of Justice Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

SELECTION PROCESS

Each candidate's background will be evaluated based on the information submitted. Only the most qualified candidates will be invited to the next phase of the recruitment process, which may include an oral panel interview and/or written or practical exercises. Candidates who pass the examination process will be submitted to the City for consideration for final selection.

Successful candidates will be required to undergo a standard Police background investigation, including a polygraph exam, psychological evaluation, and complete physical exam with drug screening.
