The Public Works Department is seeking an innovative and proactive Engineering Division Manager who will be responsible for leading and managing the design, engineering and construction management to advance and protect the capital investments in the City's critical public infrastructure.

- Provide strategic and tactical planning by leveraging knowledge of engineering while aligning with the City's overall goals.
