### CRIME ANALYST

This position will be responsible for supporting the Chief of Police and Command Staff within the Police Department by providing professional, technical, administrative, and analytical assistance related to crime analysis and operational decision-making. The incumbent will work on projects and assignments involving the collection, validation, and analysis of crime reports, calls for service, arrest data, and other public safety information to identify trends, patterns, and emerging issues. The position will develop and prepare analytical products such as reports, summaries, bulletins, presentations, and staff reports, and will support department planning and resource deployment through clear, accurate, and timely information. The incumbent will also complete proofreading and related analytical tasks, along with general administrative work and the management of confidential and sensitive law enforcement information and files. This position is in person and is required to regularly work onsite at the Police Department Building. 9/80 flex schedule option available. Remote or hybrid work is not available for this role.

## THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate is motivated to master the fundamentals of crime analysis and grow into deeper expertise in public safety data and operational decision support. They enjoy team projects, communicate proactively, and work well with a variety of people and working styles. They understand and apply customer service principles and strategies, and they contribute to a positive, solutions-oriented environment. They are flexible, adapt well to change, take ownership of work, and maintain a sense of humor while working with purpose. They bring strong analytical ability and are comfortable using computer-based systems, databases, and tools like Excel, Word, and PowerPoint to produce high-quality, decision-ready products.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

*Any combination of education, experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities are qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:*

### Experience

One or more years of experience performing analytical work involving data collection, interpretation, reporting, or crime analysis, preferably in a law enforcement, criminal justice, or public safety setting.

### Education

Possession of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in criminology, criminal justice, public administration, statistics, data analysis, geographic information systems, or a related field.

Additional experience may be substituted for education on a year-for-year basis.

### Licenses & Certificates

Certification in crime or intelligence analysis from a recognized professional organization such as the International Association of Crime Analysts (IACA), International Association of Law Enforcement Intelligence Analysts (IALEIA), or the Department of Justice (DOJ) is desirable, though not required.

Prior to appointment, candidates will be required to pass a background check (at no cost to the candidate) including the following:

- Criminal History /Personal History background check
- Fingerprint examination with no felony, domestic violence, or misdemeanor assault convictions
- Pre-employment psychological testing
- Polygraph exam
- Reference Check

**Note:** Internal candidates may be required to complete the above-mentioned background requirements.

2. Please share an example of a time you analyzed crime or calls-for-service data to identify a pattern, series, or emerging issue. Describe the methods and tools you used, the conclusions you reached, and how your analysis supported an operational response, investigative direction, or resource deployment decision.
3. Please describe your experience collecting, validating, and managing data from multiple sources (for example, RMS/CAD systems, spreadsheets, databases, or external data sets). Include your approach to ensuring data accuracy and integrity, and describe a time you corrected or resolved a data quality issue.
4. Please check the box applicable to your level and experience with Excel and/or other related software.
