The Public Works Department is organized by division: Administrative, Engineering, Maintenance, and Water Quality Control Plant. The Equipment Mechanic is one of six crews assigned to the Maintenance Division. As part of the Fleet Maintenance team, the Equipment Mechanic will help service over 300 pieces of motorized equipment within the City's fleet of vehicles and mechanical equipment.
