**Salary:** \$5,312—\$8,082 per month, plus excellent benefits.

**The Position:** A Police Officer with the Simi Valley Police Department is responsible for the performance of law enforcement duties to protect life and property in accordance with applicable laws, and other related duties as assigned. Officers may be assigned to work in a wide variety of assignments, including Patrol, Traffic, Narcotics, Detectives, Off-Road and Street Motorcycle Patrol, Special Weapons Team, Crisis Negotiation Team, D.A.R.E. Officers, Canine, Background Investigations, School Resource and Intelligence.

The Department functions on a 4/10 work schedule.

**Requires:** Requires equivalent to graduation from high school. Must have completed a California P.O.S.T. Certified Police Academy or be currently enrolled and successfully graduate.

Must be at least 21 years of age at time of appointment, possess a valid California driver's license at time of appointment, and be a U.S. citizen or meet citizenship requirements. Must be willing to work night or day shifts, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.
