THE SELECTION

PROCESS

Candidates must submit a completed job application, Resume and Cover Letter. Application packets will be screened and candidates considered best qualified will move forward to a competitive examination process, which may include a written exam, practical skills exam, an oral interview, fingerprinting/background check or medical examination process if applicable. Eligible lists are used for Full-Time (40 hrs./wk. with benefits), Part-Time (20-39 hrs./wk. with benefits), and Public Service employee (PSE) temporary (limited benefits).

THE POSITION

The PSE – Public Works Maintenance Worker I/II position performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled labor in the construction, maintenance and repair of County roads, bridges, culverts and other related structures, and in various traffic control maintenance and repair activities or in the various solid waste site activities of the Public Works Agency. This position may operate a variety of construction, maintenance and transportation equipment as necessary to complete daily tasks. The PSE – Public Works Maintenance Worker I is the entry/journey-level class series, and is distinguished from the next higher classification of PSE - Public Works Maintenance Worker II in that the latter is the entry/journey level responsible to perform a wider range of duties in the assigned maintenance area and is required to have a Class B driver's license with appropriate endorsements. This position is at-Will, Temporary and scheduled for up to forty (40) hours per week.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

- Will have experience in road maintenance or construction trade.
- Will have possession of a Class B driver's license for the PSE II-Public Works Maintenance Worker II position.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Prepares roads for patch repairs, overlays, or chip seals; prepares mix for patching roads; repairs and reconstructs roads.
- Prunes trees and other vegetation as needed.
- Cleans roadsides and drainage systems; inspects and clears debris from drainage systems; conducts roadside burning as needed.
- Hauls materials to and from work sites as required.
- Directs and controls traffic around work sites.
- Forms, pours, and finishes concrete.
- Maintains, cleans, and performs minor repairs to assigned equipment and tools.
