The Public Works Maintenance Worker I performs a variety of routine and semi-skilled public works maintenance duties including operating a variety of light and heavy mobile equipment, such as trucks of various sizes, loaders, sweepers, rollers, graders, and snow removal equipment. Incumbents may advance to the higher level after gaining experience, demonstrating proficiency, and obtaining the proper licensing required to meet the qualifications for the higher class level.

Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate has knowledge of public works and road construction, maintenance and repair activities such as roads, trees and landscaping, bridges and drainage systems; Equipment used in the construction and maintenance of roads, culverts, bridges, traffic control signs and related construction and repair work; Safe work methods and safety regulations related to the work including handling hazardous materials. Additionally, the ideal candidate has the ability to accept and apply instructions and constructive feedback and work as a strong team player.

Required Qualifications

Minimum: Graduation from high school and one year of experience in public works, road or related maintenance work.

Preferred: In addition to the minimum, a valid California Class A or B driver's license with a tanker endorsement and one additional year of experience in public works, road or related maintenance work, preferably in a public agency setting.
