THE SELECTION

PROCESS

Candidates must submit a completed job application, Resume and Cover Letter. Application packets will be screened and candidates considered best qualified will move forward to a competitive examination process, which may include a written exam, practical skills exam, an oral interview, fingerprinting/background check or medical examination process if applicable. Eligible lists are used for Full-Time (40 hrs./wk. with benefits), Part-Time (20-39 hrs./wk. with benefits), and Public Service employee (PSE) temporary (limited benefits).

THE POSITION

The Public Works Maintenance Worker III operates a variety of heavy construction, maintenance and transportation equipment as necessary to complete assignments in the maintenance of roadways, drainage systems and the County solid waste site; performs semi-skilled and skilled maintenance tasks. This is the journey-level class in the Public Works Maintenance class series, and is distinguished from the Public Works Maintenance Worker II by the primary responsibility to operate heavy diesel and gasoline-powered construction equipment in the maintenance of roadways, drainage systems and the County solid waste site. May supervise paving crew. This position is scheduled for forty (40) hours per week. This recruitment may be used to establish a list to fill future vacancies for the next six (6) months.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidate will be able to communicate clearly and perform the duties assigned following safety guidelines and regulations.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Operates heavy construction equipment, including a backhoe, bulldozer, motor grader, front loader, road mixer, chip spreader, semi-trucks, dump trucks, water trucks, boom truck, power broom, tractor, rollers, snow plow, etc., as needed for daily construction, maintenance and repair tasks.
- Prepares roads for patch repairs, overlays, or chip seals; prepares mix for patching roads; repairs and reconstructs roads.
- Constructs and repairs bridges, culverts and drain pipes; installs guard rails.
- Grades and crowns roads.
- Removes snow and ice from roads in inclement weather; removes mud / debris resulting from mud slides.
- Maintains, cleans and performs minor repairs to assigned equipment and tools.
