


POLICE OFFICER/ LATERAL

REQUIREMENTS

- Current Sworn Officer with 1+ year of full-time experience in a state, municipal, or county agency.
- U.S. citizenship or meeting citizenship requirements.
- Must be 21 as of date of hire.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Valid driver's license.

BENEFITS

Retirement:

• CalPERS Pension (3% @ 55 or 2.7% @ 57 plans; 12% employee contribution)

Retiree Health Coverage:

 City contributes \$300/month to a Retirement Health Savings Plan

Special Allowances:

- Canine: \$589/month
- Detectives, Motors, Bilingual/Spanish: \$100/month

Deferred Compensation:

• City contributes \$43/month to a 401(K) plan

Educational Incentives:

- Bachelor's degree: 5% salary increase
- Associate degree: 2.5% salary increase (requires step 4 of salary range).

POST Certification Incentives:

- Intermediate POST: 3% increase
- Advanced POST: 6% increase.

Tuition Reimbursement:

Up to \$600/year for job-related courses

Holidays:

 Eleven (11) paid holidays (10 hours each)

Annual Leave:

- Vacation and sick leave combined into one account with option to convert to salary twice yearly.
 - o 1-4 years 195 hours
 - 5+ years 234 hours
 - 10+ years 286 hours

Health Insurance:

 Medical Premiums covered at 100% for most CalPERS PPO and HMO plans

Paid Dental:

 Coverage for employees and dependents fully covered by the City

Vision:

• Coverage available for \$1.46/mo.

Disability Insurance:

Short and long-term plans provided at no cost

Life Insurance:

 \$100,000 employee coverage; \$5,000 dependent coverage, fully paid by the City

Uniform Allowance:

 \$1,600/year; uniforms and equipment provided for new hires

Flexible Spending Account:

 Medical and dependent care reimbursement accounts available

SELECTION PROCESS

Oral Appraisal Board:

All qualified applicants will appear before the board and ranked on the eligibility list.

Physical Agility Exam:

Candidates must pass the required agility tests.

- 99-Yard Obstacle Course (25 sec.)
- Body Drag (165 lbs, 14 sec.)
- Chain Link Fence (10 sec.)
- Solid Fence (13.5 sec.)
- One Mile Run (10 min.)

Background Investigation:

Includes

- medical evaluation
- psychological evaluation
- o polygraph exam
- drug/alcohol screening

OUT-OF-STATE CANDIDATES

The California Commission on POST evaluates out-of-state training to determine if candidates must attend an abbreviated or regular academy. Those required to attend are hired as Police Officer Trainees at \$5,114/month and promoted to Police Officer upon completion.
