- You are currently an active police officer.
- You possess a POST Basic Certificate.
- You have at least 3 years equivalent of CA Law Enforcement experience to patrol services with a municipality.

- You have a strong work ethic along with excellent interpersonal and customer service skills.
- You exercise good judgment and make sound decisions in emergency situations.
- You are able to build and maintain positive relationships with co-workers and supervisors.

What You'll Do

- Perform law enforcement and crime prevention work; control traffic flow and enforce state and local regulations.
- Perform investigative work.
- Participate in and provide support and assistance to special department crime prevention and enforcement programs.
- Do related police work as assigned.

What We Offer

- **Hiring Incentive:** Lateral Officers meeting the minimum qualifications listed above will be eligible for our Incentive Program: \$30,000 incentive bonus with a structured payout timeline as follows:
 \$10,000 - upon completion of FTO program
 \$10,000 - upon completion of 12-month probationary period
 \$10,000 - upon completion of 36 months of employment

- Comprehensive benefits package including generous paid leave and health benefits.
- CalPERS retirement (3% at 55 with 3-year average final comp for classic members; 2.7% at 57 with 3-year average final comp for new members); employees contribute 14% for classic members; 11.75% for new members to CalPERS with no Social Security deduction.

- Educational Incentives – 3.5% Intermediate POST, 7% Advanced POST - 3% POST Sherman Block Supervisor Leadership (if applicable)

Interview Process

Upon meeting the minimum qualifications for this position, the candidates will be placed on an eligible list. Failure to attach, email or fax your résumé and Basic POST certificate to your application, will deem you ineligible for consideration. The eligible list is updated as candidates become eligible. Applicants will be contacted by the Recruiting Sergeant if chosen to participate in an oral interview.

Note: The City of San Mateo reserves the right, at its discretion, to limit the number of qualified candidates invited to the selection process.

Fine Print

When successful, a conditional employment offer is made and candidates are then required to successfully pass a psychological, medical examination including a stress agility assessment, a polygraph, a drug screen, personal interviews, background investigation, fingerprinting, and must be able to furnish proof of legal right to work in the United States. The process will end with the Police Chief's interview. The City's standards must be met before the final appointment is made. The Chief of Police or his designee will make the final appointment.
