Applications will be screened and a limited number of the most qualified candidates will be invited to an oral interview with the Recreation Manager and/or Recreation Supervisor. A passing score of 70% is required to make the eligibility list. Recommendations for appointment from this list will be made to the Deputy City Manager, who will make the final decision. Depending on the number of applicants, this process may be altered. Prior to appointment, a background check, including fingerprinting for submission to the Department of Justice must be completed, as well as TB screening.
