The Capital engineering division manages projects ranging from a \$13m overhaul of Marin County's busiest roadway corridor, to the reconstruction of a major stormwater pump station to keep low lying areas of the City dry during winter storms; to the installation of new restroom facilities in City parks.

San Rafael is Marin's oldest (est. 1874), most diverse and traversed (by vehicles, transit and non-motorized travel) city.
