



The City of Simi Valley is accepting applications for:
Senior or Associate Engineer (Traffic)
Position may be filled at either level depending upon qualifications.

This recruitment is open until filled and may close at any time. **The first review of applications will occur on November 1, 2018, or when 75 applications are received, whichever occurs first.**

Salary: Senior Engineer, \$94,663 - \$121,738/yr, plus up to \$29,437/yr to offset the cost of medical, dental, vision, or other optional benefits. Associate Engineer, \$82,861 - \$106,395/yr, plus up to \$29,298/yr to offset the cost of medical, dental, vision, or other optional benefits.

The Position: Supervises, assigns, reviews and participates in the work of staff responsible for performing professional and technical engineering services; ensures work quality and adherence to established policies and procedures; provides specialized engineering services; and performs the more technical and complex tasks.

Ideal Candidate will:

- Possess a California Traffic Engineering License or Professional Traffic Operations Engineer certification (for Senior Engineer).
- Possess an Engineer-in-training registration (for Associate Engineer).
- Be capable of report writing and presentations.
- Possess experience analyzing citizen requests for traffic issues.
- Have experience in traffic signal design, timing, etc.
- Possess experience with traffic review of proposed developments, plan checking and traffic studies.
- Have previous public sector traffic engineering experience.
- Be familiar with traffic modeling.

Minimum Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Education: Equivalent to a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in area of assignment.

Experience: Three (Associate) or four (Senior) years of professional engineering experience related to area of assignment; and one year of administrative and/or lead supervisory responsibility (Senior).

Possession of registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of California (Senior) or Engineer-in-Training certificate for (Associate); and a valid driver's license is also required.

Selection Process: Candidates who possess the best combination of qualifications will be invited to interview; an interview is not guaranteed.

- Retirement: CalPERS 2% @ 55 or 2% @ 62 defined retirement plan. Employees currently pay a 7% contribution.
- Medical: \$133/mo, plus up to \$1,897.77/mo in "Simiflex Dollars," (cash to offset the cost of health or other optional benefits)
- Dental: A PPO and HMO plan are available. Employee cost ranges from \$0 to \$83.06 per month.
- Vision: A plan is available with a cost of \$2.66 per month.
- Life Insurance: \$101,000 for employees and \$5,000 for each dependent is provided at no cost.
- Disability Insurance: Paid by the City.
- Retirement Health Savings Plan: \$200 per month.
