Swim Instructor

(Part-time)

The City of Brisbane is currently recruiting certified Swim Instructors for our beautiful outdoor aquatic facility. Swim Instructors instruct organized aquatic safety and swim classes with the safety standards and procedures set by the American Red Cross. Swim Instructors may also serve as Lifeguards (if certified), whose duties include patrolling and watching the activities in and around the community swimming pool, enforcing regulations to prevent accidents, and rescuing swimmers in distress. SALARY AND HOURS: \$19.72 - \$20.71 – \$21.75 – \$22.84 - \$23.98 per hour (Part time position - No other benefits are offered. Initial appointments are generally made at the first step of this five-step scale). Hours will range from 20-40 hours per week.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education – Graduation from high school or GED equivalent is desirable. This provision may be waived for applicants 15 to 18 years of age with the ability to obtain a valid work permit or have worked for the City of Brisbane for at least 1 year.
- Experience – Previous experience as a lifeguard or swim instructor at a pool or open water area is desirable.
- Special Requirements – Current Lifeguarding, Water Safety Instructor, First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer certificates are encouraged.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Interested candidates must submit a completed online employment application along with a current copy of your resume and any certifications you may have at www.calopps.org/city-of-brisbane. Resumes required. **Recruitment is OPEN UNTIL FILLED.**

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applications will be screened, and a limited number of the most qualified candidates will be invited to an oral interview with the Recreation Supervisor and Head Lifeguards. Prior to appointment, a background check, including fingerprinting for submission to the Department of Justice must be completed, as well as TB screening.
