This position is a part of the City's Wastewater Treatment Team and plays an important role in the function of the Wastewater Treatment Facility. Under general supervision, Wastewater Treatment Facility Operators operate and maintain the Wastewater Treatment Facility collection system pump stations, storm stations, seepage station and perform other related work as required. Wastewater Treatment Facility Operators may also operate and maintain satellite Wastewater Facilities. An Operator III provides lead direction to other workers, but has no supervisory responsibilities. More experienced operators are expected to be able to operate the facility independently and assist with training other operators.

Required Qualifications

Education: Education equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade is required.
