ABOUT MILL VALLEY PUBLIC WORKS

Mill Valley is a full-service city located 10 miles north of San Francisco and has a rich history with engaged residents. Mill Valley is primarily a suburban community, with a thriving downtown and distinctive residential neighborhoods. The City's approximately 14,000 residents live in a 4.8 sq. mile area.

Public Works includes the divisions of Engineering, Operations (Building, Parks, Streets and Sewers, and Fleet Maintenance). With the complement of 47 staff, a \$5.6 million operational budget, and oversight of the \$30 million 5-year Capital Improvement Program, the department offers a full range of services and support for residents, businesses, and City departments.

ABOUT THE POSITION

As a Maintenance Worker II in our Parks Division, you will play a hands-on role in keeping Mill Valley's beautiful outdoor spaces safe, clean, and welcoming for the community. Working under general supervision, you will take on a variety of skilled tasks, including pruning trees, mowing lawns, maintaining park structures, and supporting restoration efforts.

Your daily work may take you from trail maintenance in the scenic foothills of Mt. Tamalpais to creek restoration projects along the historic Corte Madera Creek to caring for athletic fields with stunning views of Richardson Bay. This is active, outdoor work that keeps you moving and involves bending, lifting, pushing, pulling, and navigating varied terrain across both developed parks and natural open spaces.

If you enjoy working outdoors and making a visible difference in your community, this could be a great opportunity for you.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

To excel in this position, someone must be responsible, safety-conscious, and bring a positive attitude to hands-on, outdoor work. They should enjoy working with their hands and contributing to the care and maintenance of parks, trails, and landscaped areas.

Minimum qualifications include a high school diploma or GED and at least three (3) years of experience in grounds maintenance or gardening involving the care of flowers, ornamental shrubs, and trees.

Additional skills such as pruning and trimming, irrigation repair, and basic carpentry or masonry work are highly valued.
