All candidates must apply for the H2 Firefighter position through Smart Recruiters and obtain placement on the FCTC Statewide Eligible list at the application deadline.

H2 Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 19 years of age (to apply).
- High School Diploma or GED.
- Valid California Driver's License.
- NREMT
- BLS "Healthcare Provider" CPR certification from American Heart Association, American Red Cross, or American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI)
- Passing Score of 70% on the FCTC exam.
- FCTC Candidate Physical Ability Test card.

Create an account with FCTC

- · Register for the FCTC written test
- Register for the FCTC Candidate Physical Ability Test
- Upload your EMT credentials, HS diploma/GED, and driver's license to your FCTC portal

If you are already on the FCTC Statewide Eligibility List, you must submit an application for the H2 Firefighter position through Smart Recruiters to make the DHR H2 Firefighter Eligible List.

Candidates on the City and County of San Francisco Department of Human Resources H2 Firefighter Eligible List will remain on this list for two years.
